Sacrament of Confirmation

The Sacrament of Confirmation will be celebrated in the Parish this year on Sunday 19 September at the 5pm Mass. Enrolment forms are in the foyers of each Church and will be available at the office in Sacred Heart and St John's College's. You are invited to complete the enrolment form and return it to the Parish Office by Monday 2 August.

Those eligible to receive the sacrament of Confirmation are:

- any student in Year 11 or above who has been baptised Catholic;
- adults who have been baptised but who have not received the Sacrament of Confirmation.

There will be a preparation programme for the sacrament and information on this will be available after enrolments close in August.

This sacrament is an important step of the initiation process into full communion with the Church. It is an opportunity for people to make their own free choice of entering more fully into the life of Christ through the gifts of the Holy Spirit.

The next monthly meeting will be held on Friday 30 July at 9:30am in the meeting room at St Patrick's Church, Napier.


Catholic Parish of Napier Administration and **Mission Centre**
