Resumption of Weekday Masses

It is with great joy that we were able to return last Friday to the celebration of Mass on week-days. We have received very clear requirements from the Diocese for the use of churches including:

- masks must be worn by everyone while in church;
- people entering the church must sign in using the COVID-19 tracer app or sign in manually, and use hand sanitizer;
- parishioners need to keep the social distancing of 2m spacing;
- Holy Communion is to be distributed, only on the hand;
- Holy Water fonts are to remain empty;
- When distributing Holy Communion, the priests and Eucharistic ministers must keep their masks on;
- When coming forward to receive Holy Communion, parishioners are to keep 2m away from others, keep their masks on when receiving the host (on the hand), step to one side, remove their mask to receive the host and then replace it as they make their way back to their seat. (In the case of those who use walking aids, those ministering Holy Communion can use their discretion).

You will see from these requirements and especially with the need to ensure 2 meter spacing between people that it is impossible to celebrate Sunday Mass with the large numbers who come to Mass on Sundays in the Parish. We will need to wait until we return to Level 1.


PFG 30th Birthday Celebratory Mass & Luncheon
