

Sunday Masses

At the COVID press conference last Monday there was no mention of any increase in the number of people allowed to attend Church services. It continues to remain at 100. This is in contrast to the unlimited numbers now allowed in hospitality and sporting venues providing they are able to maintain social distancing.

In the present circumstances at Alert Level 2 we are still unable to celebrate Sunday Masses. I hope in the coming week there may be some information on the change to the numbers allowed in churches to better reflect what is happening in other settings. If that happens it would enable us to return to the celebration of Sunday Mass. In the meantime you are encouraged to attend a Mass during the week.

Administration and Mission Centre

We have finally received Building Consent from the Napier City Council for the planned Administration and Mission Centre. This welcomed news allows us to move to the construction stage of the project.

I wish to thank those who have been involved in this project for the last three years. It was in 2018 that we first entered into discussions with the Diocese about the future planning for the Catholic Parish of Napier. The Diocese gave approval that:

- a) we would not renew the tenancy for the rental property in Wharerangi Road at the end of October 2018 for the priests who were living there;
- b) the priests would move back into the Presbytery at St Mary's at the beginning of November 2018;
- b) planning would begin for a new Administration and Mission complex on the St Patrick's site.

Since November 2018 the priests have shared the presbytery with the Parish Office. This is not a desired or perfect arrangement but it has saved the Parish approximately \$100,000 in rent over the past three years.

I am very grateful to the Diocese, our professional consultants and also to the Parish Finance Committee for their support and encouragement during the last three years. In particular I sincerely thank Jonathan Bissell, (the inaugural Chair of the Finance Committee) when our three parishes became the Catholic Parish of Napier. Jonathan has been invaluable in bringing to the project not only his professional expertise but also the background knowledge of the transition of St Patrick's, St Thomas More and St Mary's into one Catholic Parish.

While there is still much to do (fundraising etc) we have reached the point when in the next few weeks work will begin on the site. Please keep this project in your prayers and especially those who will work on the construction of our new building

Support Life Sunday - 10 October 2021

Every day we witness the testimony of courage and sacrifice of healthcare workers. Pope Francis: Message for International Nurses Day 2020

"Supporting and honouring health carers" is the theme of Support Life Sunday on 10 October. This year's focus acknowledges the work of health carers, including family carers and health professionals, who are on the frontline in supporting and protecting life.

The change of name and focus to Support Life Sunday recognises that we need to move beyond political debate or legal argument and extend to active, practical support for people facing a range of life challenges at the beginning of life, throughout life, and at the end of life. Health carers are currently under intense pressure because of the Covid-19 pandemic, as well as experiencing the impact of recent changes to New Zealand's abortion and euthanasia legislation. Health carers are also witnesses to the ongoing impact on health and life of poverty, exclusion, attitudes towards disabilities, and addictions.

Pope Francis has acknowledged and thanked health carers in many statements throughout the Covid-19 pandemic. This year's Support Life Sunday resources share the stories of health carers who are examples of people who support life in their homes, jobs, and careers. Each of our parishes and communities has many such examples. This is an opportunity to acknowledge and support those who support life.
