SYNOD 2021/2023

On 7 March 2020 Pope Francis announced a synod "For a Synodal Church: Communion, Participation, and Mission". In May 2021, the Synodal process was changed into a three year journey for every diocese worldwide, culminating in Rome in 2023. Pope Francis wants everyone to participate. He wants to hear the voice of all the baptized, especially those whose voices are seldom heard.

The Diocese is in the process of creating a team to plan and lead our diocesan synod. They will be responsible for resourcing parish communities, for promoting the synod and for encouraging participation. The official website for the synod is: https://www.synod.va/en/html

At Christian Lovelink the referrals and requests for assistance are a constant stream and have increased significantly over the last 12 months. The need out there in the Hawkes Bay Community continues to grow. We are thankful to all those who donate goods and help us to help others.

The main area of need at this time is for beds. So far this year (as at the end of August) Christian Lovelink has helped over 500 families and given out 377 beds. We continue to receive requests for beds on a daily basis. If you know of any surplus beds, are upgrading your bed, or downsizing your home, we would love to have your old ones (they need to be in good useable condition with no rips or stains).




